Buster April 30, 1921

Moved by J. A. Loubt - seconded by Chas. Weisgerber that S. B. Slapin be appointed Secretary, Treasurer for the village of Buster for the year 1921, and till April 30, 1922.

Moved by Chas Weisgerber, seconded by Wm. Buehring that the tax on male dogs be 2⁰⁰ & female dogs 3⁰⁰ per year consecutive year. and any dog found without a tag or any stray dog on or after May 15th 1921 will be ~~destroyed~~ destroyed within twenty-four hours.

Moved by Chas Weisgerber, seconded by Wm Buehring that the Council have the power to borrow money not exceeding \$150⁰⁰.

Moved by Chas Weisgerber seconded by Wm Buehring that fowl of any kind be kept enclosed inside of owners premises and any fowl running at large after May 15th the owner will be assessed \$1.00 per head and to pay all damage caused by said fowl. This to be in effect from May 15th till November 15th.

X Moved by Chas Weisgerber, seconded by Wm Buehring that no cows or bulls be allowed to run at large after May 15th.

Moved by Chas Weisgerber seconded by Wm Buehring that ^{no} cattle or horses ~~be~~ be allowed to run at large after May 15th 1921.
 and not before Oct 15th

Moved by J. A. Loubt - seconded by Wm Buehring that no hogs be allowed to be kept in the village of Buster on or after May 15th 1921.

Moved by J. A. Loubt - seconded by Chas Weisgerber that C. Steinbock be appointed official dog destroyer of any stray dogs. The amount to be paid for by the Council and buying of same after May 15th.

Moved by Chas Weisgerber seconded by Wm Buehring that any manure that is now accumulated shall be removed before May 15th and not more than one wagon load be allowed to accumulate after May 15th.

Moved by Wm Buehring seconded by J.A. Lount that no one be allowed to store goods more than one hour on the sidewalks after May 15th.

Moved by Wm Buehring seconded by Chas. Weisgerber that no one be allowed to post any advertising matter without paying five dollar for the privilege after May 15th.

Moved by Chas Weisgerber seconded by Wm Buehring that the dray license be \$3⁰⁰ per current year. To take effect after May 15th.

Moved by Wm Buehring seconded by Chas Weisgerber that no one be allowed to discharge any fire arms in the village of Beiseker without permission from the Council after May 15th.

Moved by J.A. Lount seconded by Chas Weisgerber that any person or persons who has not an established place of business or an authorized agent resident of the town shall pay a tax of \$10⁰⁰ for the current year after May 15th. 1921:-

A meeting of the Council was held in J.A. Lount's office, all members present, a goodly number of the ratepayers were present and heartily approved of the following business.

Moved by Chas F. Weisgerber, that the rate of assessment be same in valuation as that of the Beiseker Consolidated School and the Rate of Taxation be (5) mills on the Dollar. This was seconded by E. W. Buehring and carried.
