Moved by G. W. Buehring seconded by C. F. Weisgerber that May 10<sup>th</sup> 1922 be the General Cleanup Day in the Village of Beiseker: - carried!

Moved by F. A. Lount seconded by G. W. Buehring that the sec-treas be authorized to hire Jacob Mix to haul straw into Big Rockefeller Slough in between C. P. Ry and block 14 at \$1.00 per load: - carried!

Moved by C. F. Weisgerber seconded by F. A. Lount that the fill on First Ave be done as convenient that the wages to be paid shall not exceed four dollars and fifty cents per day for man and team and equipment, and three dollars for man, and in all cases to find their own board and lodging. The work to be completed not later than June the 3<sup>rd</sup> - 1922: - carried!
