A special meeting of the Council of the Village of Beiseker was held in P. A. Lount's and notice of same is hereby waived. All councillors present.

The minutes of the previous meeting were read and adopted with the exception of payment of sidewalks to Schmaetz, Schmaetz, Hirst and N. Gordon.

The secretary was advised to write to the Department of Municipal Affairs re said sidewalks and ask their advice as to payment of same.

The secretary was also asked to write the Alberta Pacific Grain Co., Alberta Pool Elevator and the U. G. Ltd re lighting their houses here.

It was moved that the Dray Licence for the year 1929 be \$12.00 per year.

It was moved that the Village draying be let by tender and all drayman who have paid their license would be entitled to submit a bid for such work. The drayman to submit a price per load for garbage, ashes, ground and etc.

The drayman authorized to do this work must submit monthly statements and if found correct will be paid 50% monthly and the balance will be retained by Council until the end of the year for faithful performance of such duties.
