Agreement:

I, Richard Kail, Drayman, of the Village of Beiseker, in the Province of Alberta, do hereby agree to haul garbage, ground, ashes or anything of a like nature which the Council of the said Village may request me to do at and for a price of fifty cents (.50¢) per load for and during the year 1929.

It is understood that my conduct in connection with such work shall be governed by the rules, of said Council, which are now in force or may hereafter be brought into force.

and I further agree to do all such work promptly and to endeavor to keep the said Village clean and sanitary and respectable, so far as my work is concerned, at all times. I further agree to accept one-half the payment of my monthly statements, which I will render promptly on the first day of each month, and the balance of these payments shall be retained by said Council to insure the faithful performance of my duties.
