

Feb. 11, 1929.

A special meeting of the Council of the Village of Beiseker was held in F. A. Lount's office and notice of meeting is hereby waived. All councillors present.

The minutes of the previous meeting were read and adopted.

Mr. Anderson, Secretary-Treasurer, verbally asked to be relieved of his position, advising the council that he did not wish to do the work and that as Miss Weper had been satisfactory in the past, that he would like her to continue the work. This was satisfactory to the Council and Miss Weper accepted the position as Secretary-Treasurer.

The Secretary-Treasurer was authorized to pay the Matthews Publishing Co \$5.00 for Bond.

The Secretary-Treasurer was advised to write the Department of Municipal Affairs and enclose report of councillors as per nomination and advise Department as to resignations of councillors and re-election again.

The matter of Village police man was discussed and Henry Ripschneider was duly appointed and authorized to be superintendent and to receive as his remuneration for the year 1929 one-half of the fines under his jurisdiction and at the end of the year, if he has done his work faithfully, he is to receive an additional \$10.00.

It was also resolved that as Mr. Anderson had never taken possession of the Village books that a new audit was not necessary as the former Secretary is again in charge.

Notice of Scheffelmaier Hospital account

was discussed and tabled until further notice.

It was authorized that the management of the rink be notified that the Senior Hockey team practise hours be changed to the hours of 5:30 to 6:30 p.m. on Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday night. This change is granted only on the understanding that this Hockey team and any and every member thereof conducts themselves properly at all times within the rink and uses his best endeavors for the welfare, protection and the care of the property of the rink in every way. And at no time when the ice is soft shall they use this ice to the detriment of the public skating in the evening.

Moved that the meeting adjourn.
