It was moved and seconded that F. A. Lount act as Mayor for the year 1930. carried.

It was moved and seconded that Henry Reipschneider act as Constable for the year 1930 at a salary of \$10.00. carried

Mr. Weisgerber was appointed to see Mr. Dutton re cleaning of hall above the store.

Dr. Fowler was appointed health officer for the year 1930.

H. Ueber was asked to clean out culverts.

Mr. Stinae agreed to hire J. Pibel to drain water off road opposite P. N. Elevator.

A 24" sidewalk was authorized for back sides of 7th Street between blocks 2 and 3. and on the West side of Block 2 between 6th and 7th Street.

The Backs of Office were duly signed.

The matter of chicken pox was discussed and after thorough investigation and also after consulting Health Officer it was decided that no quarantine should be issued.

The secretary was authorized to write Department re Gutman ice cream parlor and early closing.

The council approved of Mrs. Gimbel moving a house 24' x 32' on lots 32 & 33 Block 3.
