The minutes of the previous meeting were read and adopted.

The total assessment for the Village amounted to \$213,735.00 and it was found necessary to set a rate of 8 mills to cover expenses for the current year.

Due to the Supp. Rev. Assessment of \$22.80 it was found necessary to set this rate at 3 mills as it is impossible to raise this amount on a 2 mill rate on the land valuation of this Village.
