The appeal of Mr Baunerman, King George Hotel was heard and after due consideration the assessment was lowered to \$6600<sup>00</sup>.

The appeal of National Elevator Co. represented by their agent, Mr Campbell, was heard and their assessment was changed to read as follows, as per information supplied by the company:-

Capacity of Elevator 26000 bushels  
Constructed in 1917.

Depreciation = 4 years @  $2\frac{1}{2}\%$  = 10%.

Rate per bushel = 34¢.

26000 bus @ 34¢ - - - - \$8840.00

Less 4 yrs Depreciation @ 10% - 884.00  
\$7956.00

Assessment at  $\frac{2}{3}$  value

\$5304.00 assessment

The elevator and coal shed site \$200.00 and \$50.00, respectively, was canceled.

The appeal of Pearl Grain Company, represented by their agent, Mr Wald, was heard and assessment changed to read as follows, as per information obtained by the company:-

Depreciation = 7 years @  $2\frac{1}{2}\%$  =  $17\frac{1}{2}\%$

Rate of assessment per bus. 34¢

29000 bus @ 34¢ - - - - \$9860.00

Less 7 yrs. Depreciation @  $17\frac{1}{2}\%$  - - - 1725.50

\$8134.50

Assessment @  $\frac{2}{3}$  value

\$5423.00
