A special meeting of the Council of the Village of Beiseker was held in F. D. Lount's office and notice of meeting is hereby waived. All members of the Council were present.

The minutes of the previous meeting were read and adopted.

The following bills were authorized to be paid:-

Several applications were received by the Secretary for the position of caretaker for the rink. These were thoroughly discussed and it was decided to give it to M. W. Stout at \$30.00 per month, subject to termination at the pleasure of the Council.

This was not the lowest nor the highest bid, the lowest bid being \$20.00 per mo & the highest \$50.00 but Mr Stout was conditional in as much as he was to receive no part of this money; the same to be applied on his arrears of Village taxes and should there be any amount left over it should then be applied on school tax arrears, and he was accordingly accepted. (Commencing work on December 8, 1931.)

Moved that the meeting adjourn.
