A special meeting of the Council of the Village of Beiseker was held in F. B. Laurent's office and notice of meeting is hereby waived.

All members of the Council were present.

The minutes of the previous meeting were read and adopted.

It was decided that nomination meeting be held on February 6, 1933 in the Secretary's office ^{at 8 o'clock} for the discussion of the affairs of the Village at 7 p.m.

The Secretary was authorized to post notices for nomination meeting.

It was moved that the dray license be reduced from \$5.00 to \$3.00. Dog license to remain the same and the secretary was asked to get suitable tags.

The extension of 6th street to the paved highway was again discussed and tabled until next meeting.

The Village police, Mr. N. Riesebrieder was reengaged for the year 1933 at a salary of Ten Dollars \$10.00 per year and was authorized to appear before a Justice of Peace and take oath of Office and bring account of charges to the Secretary.

E. W. Wegner was appointed Secretary Treasurer at a salary of \$100.00 per year and as assessor at a salary of \$50.00 per year and was authorized to arch for bonds covering same as demanded by law.

J. N. Schmalz was appointed auditor for the year 1933 and the secretary was asked to notify the Department accordingly.

The Secretary was authorized to buy necessary stationery, including cash book & Tax Roll. A sample sheet of the new approved Tax Roll was submitted by the

Secretary for the Council's approval
and it was agreed that this book would
possibly meet the requirements enacted by
Law for the next two years.

Moved that the meeting adjourn.
