The minutes of the previous meeting were read and adopted.

The sale of Kohrke lots was again discussed and it was decided not to advertise these lots for sale until fall.

Arminius Schmeltz was to supervise grading of streets and report to Council at next meeting.

After reading the correspondence from the Department re highway connection it was decided no work could be done until we had further advice from the Department.

Mr. Gordon attended the meeting re store-keeping open on holidays and Sundays. The topic was thoroughly discussed but nothing decided.

Mr. D. F. Weisgerber is to act as secretary-treasurer during the absence of Ed Wefer, Secretary-Treasurer.

The consolidation of taxes was discussed. The Council decided they would not avail themselves of the Act.

Mr. Reipschneider was authorized to repair park fence and hitching posts on both sides of the town.

The C. P. R. Railway crossing north of the Village was found to be too narrow and Mr. Weisgerber was asked to see C. P. Section foreman with a view to have planks extended to take care of the traffic.
