Dr. Milne's statement for 79⁰⁰ (60⁰⁰ if paid in full would be accepted) re Mrs Scheffelmaier, was discussed and it was decided to take this matter up later after some information had been obtained from Mr Ferguson, C.P.R. Dept. regarding Mr. Scheffelmaier receiving assistance from C.P.R. in case of sickness. The secretary was asked to write Dr. Milne and advise him that the account would be discussed at a later date.

Mr Stratford asked the council for permission to harbor yoes within the Village limits. This matter was thoroughly discussed and it was moved that the permission not be granted. The secretary to advise Mr Stratford accordingly.

The secretary was asked to get a statement from Crown Lumber Co. for the account of the Village in full.

A permit to obtain a restaurant license was given to Sam Lee and Lee Nam, to operate a restaurant in the King George Hotel, on lots 26 & 27.

The Secretary was asked to write Norway Municipality regarding the C.P.R. crossing as nothing has been done to better the condition of the crossing which is now too narrow and dangerous to persons crossing.

The connection of 6th Street to the main highway was again thoroughly discussed but it was decided that nothing definite could be done until further advice was received from the Dept. of Public Works.
