A special meeting of the Village of Beiseker was held in F. A. Laurent's office and notice of meeting is hereby waived.

All members of the Council were present. The minutes of the previous meeting were read and adopted.

Mr Jack Delzer attended the meeting and entered into an agreement with the Council whereby he is to give the new road allowance as now surveyed by the Department of Public Works to the Village of Beiseker, free of all encumbrances or attachments of any kind whatsoever and in remuneration for same was to receive 9th Street now owned by the Village of Beiseker as shown on the registered plan thereof, same to be free of all encumbrances and attachments.

The Village of Beiseker further agreed with the said Jack Delzer that they will pay for the necessary posts to rebuild the fence along the South side of the newly surveyed road connection between Sixth Street and the West fence of the C. N. R. right-of-way.

The Secretary was authorized to submit the following scale of wages to be used for the construction of said connection to the Department of Public Works, for its approval:-
