Dec. 16. 1933.

A special meeting of the Council of the Village of Beiseker was held in Mr Laurent's office and notice of meeting is hereby revised. All councillors were present.

The minutes of the previous meeting were read and adopted.

E. M. Anderson having applied for relief for himself, his wife, and one boy eleven years of age and his son, Harold Anderson, 21 years of age, claiming that he also was destitute; the Council met for the purpose of taking care of this application, together with arranging for the necessary assistance.

After some discussion, and owing to the fact that the boys and girls of the Village had repeatedly asked the Council to operate the rink, and also to the fact that there were two able bodied men in this family, the Council came to the conclusion that they would open the rink for the benefit of the boys and girls, and authorized E. M. Anderson and Harold Anderson to do this work and authorized payment to him of \$25.00 to supply his necessities and expected to get a small return from the rink.
