The minutes of the previous meeting were read and adopted.

The Anderson relief account was discussed and it was decided that this Council would not pay rent and that the reference to the payment of such rent in the minutes of the meeting under date of Jan. 15, 1934 is hereby rescinded.

The amount of relief to be paid to Andersons for April is to be decided on at a later date.

Mr Weiskner was asked to interview Mr. Stratford regarding a license for his dog as many complaints had been coming in.

The secretary was authorized to purchase the necessary books for the assessment for the year 1934, also a new cash book.

The Supplementary Revenue Tax account was taken up with the Department of Municipal affairs, personally, by Mr Lount, and he reported a satisfactory settlement, as the Village ~~now~~ is only required to levy \$5.43 for the year 1934 and remit the arrears of \$659.12 to the Department as they are collected. A letter is on file, also a copy attached to the assessment roll, explaining fully the arrangements.
