"Court of Revision"

The Council of the Village of Beiseker formed a Court of Revision to hear complaints.

The following complaints were lodged:-

Mrs. Peter Borroath, Part 13-28-26-104th. assessment too high.

L. Bannerman. Lots 26, 27, Blk. 1, Plaw 4011X, Valuation too high.

Peter Septro, Lots 35, 36, 37 Plaw 5798 E.A. valued too high.

The assessment on Part 13-28-26-104th in the name of Mrs. Peter Borroath, was reduced \$100⁰⁰.

After much discussion it was decided that the assessment on land values and improvements should be reduced as the value in many of these was too high compared with the actual cash value. The Railroads and Elevators, ^{oil warehouses & coal sheds.} are assessed as nearly accurate as possible and such assessments approved and recommended by the Department and this action in assessment was to bring other valuations in line with them.

This action in no way interferes with the business assessment.

The assessment on lots to be reduced 50%.

The assessment on improvements to be reduced 25% of the present assessment.

Moved that the Court adjourn.
