was presented to the Council requesting that a By-Law be enacted declaring Wednesday afternoon a half holiday from the first day of June until the first fifteenth day of August, inclusive.

This petition came up for consideration and the Council after interviewing several of the ratepayers, who had signed the petition together with a member of Elevator Grain Buyers and Oil Warehouse Representatives, decided that the wish, of such a large majority of the business places concerned, should be granted and the following By-Law was enacted.

By-Law No. 29.

of the Village of Beiseker.

A By-Law Relating to Wednesday Half Holiday.

The Council of the Village of Beiseker enacts as follows:-

That all lumberyards, General Stores, Hardware Stores, Meat Markets, Barber Shops, Blacksmith Shops, Harness and Shoe Repair Shops, Oil Warehouses and Elevators, shall be closed from 12 o'clock noon on each Wednesday between the first of June and the 15<sup>th</sup> of August

inclusive.

Excepting when some other legal holiday falls in the same week.

Done and Passed in Council assembled this first day of June A.D. 1934.

This By-Law received its first, second and third reading, with all members of the Council present, and was carried unanimously, and is to become effective at once.
