The application of N. Gordon, Agent for Drumheller Flour Co., of Drumheller, for a permit to build a warehouse 14 x 20 x constructed of lumber at an approximate cost of \$ on lot 7, Block 1, Plan 4011X, in the Village of Beiseker, Alberta, was discussed by the Council and approved.

The Secretary was asked to issue permit covering same.
