

Beiseker, Alberta

Feb. 18, 1935.

A special meeting of the Council of the Village of Beiseker was held in Mr. Launt's office on Feb. 18th and notice of meeting is hereby waived.

Councillors present, namely, F. A. Launt, Mayor, P. Schmaltz & A. F. Weiszgober, Councillors.

The minutes of the previous meeting were read and adopted.

The following accounts were authorized to be paid:-

#75. Kreeger's Garage, repair to truck engine #8.35

The Secretary was asked to write the Supervisor of Charity & Relief re George Usselman and obtain as much information as possible.

John Usselman applied for relief and was granted a ton of coal and groceries for Feb. 19th to Mar. 19th, not to exceed \$10⁰⁰.

George Usselman applied for relief, but as this family is a charge on the Municipality of Keosauqua, his application was turned over to J. N. Schmaltz, one of the Councillors of that Municipality.

Business assessment was discussed and it was moved that By-Law No 25 relating to the assessment of trades, businesses & professions be repealed and the following By-law be passed:-

By-Law No. 25A.

The Council of the Village of Beiseker enacts as follows:-

That any trade, business or profession carried on within its corporate limits shall be assessed an annual assessment thereof, to be known as a business tax

That the rates for the different trades, businesses or professions for the purpose of assessment and taxation, under this By-law, shall be on the basis of the number of square feet of the entire floor space of the entire premises occupied for the purpose of such trade, business or profession, as follows:-

- Banks and General Stores \$5⁰⁰ per square foot of floor space
- Railway Companies \$4⁰⁰ " " " " " "
- Blacksmith shops \$1.25 " " " " " "
- Implement Dealers, Garages, hotels and oil and gasoline dealers \$2.50 per square foot of floor space

all other trades, businesses or professions not herein stipulated, \$2.50 per square foot of floor space.

The above By-Law received its first, second and third reading and was unanimously passed.

Done and passed in Council assembled this 18th day of February, A.D. 1935.

Moved that the meeting adjourn.
