The problem of relief in connection with John Haselman and family and any others that might hereafter seek relief, was thoroughly discussed, and owing to the fact that we thought it advisable that full information regarding such relief and that the whole affair should be handled systematically and under the control of proper supervision, it was therefore Resolved,

That a committee of two be appointed to look after all relief and that they should be known as 'Relief Commissioners'

The Council then appointed Joseph Schmaltz and G. F. Labrke, as such Commissioners.

Moved that the meeting adjourn.
