The following By-Law No. 35 received its 1st, 2nd and 3rd reading and was finally unanimously passed.

A By-Law Pursuant to The Social Services Tax Act. Whereas the Village of Beiseker in accordance with the provisions of The Social Services Tax Act, being Chapter 12, Statutes of Alberta, 1936, is required to levy the sum of \$114⁰⁰ being an amount equal to that which would be produced by a levy of three mills on the dollar upon the equalized assessment of all the rateable land in the Village.

Therefore the Council of the Village of Beiseker hereby enacts that a levy of 3 mills on the dollar be made against all the property in the Village which is liable to assessment and taxation for general revenue purposes

for the year 1936.

By-law No. 36 received its 1st. 2nd. & 3rd reading and was finally unanimously passed.

By-law No. 36. Relating to the mill rate for Municipal purposes for 1936.

The Council of the Village of Beiriker enacts as follows:-

That the mill rate for Municipal purposes be 7 mills, for the year 1936.
