It was brought to the attention of the Council that J. N. Schmaltz, Sec. Treas. of the Beiseker P. D. No. 55 had collected \$150.00 on E. N. Hoegl, reported arrears. It was therefore moved that the Village would not share the usual 5% commission on such taxes collected due to the fact that Mr. Schmaltz had collected this amount himself. Carried.

A letter received from Dr. Hill, Medical Health officer of Calgary was read, which stated that Agnes Usselman had called at his office re treatment for her throat and eyes. Agnes Usselman had not prior to this time interviewed the Council as to any medical attention. Mr John Usselman (relief recipient) father of Agnes Usselman, was called in and interviewed. After discussing the matter with Mr. Usselman he admitted that she knew nothing about the girl's illness, but that she had gone to Calgary to visit her sister and had during that time called at Dr. Hill's office. Mr Usselman agreed to write his daughter, Agnes, and have her return to Beiseker at once. Mr Usselman said as far as he knew Agnes required no medical attention.

The Secretary was asked to advise Dr. Hill of Calgary that John Usselman was writing his daughter Agnes and have her return to Beiseker at once.
