The auditor's financial statement was read and explained fully by the Mayor, the greatest point of interest centering around the expenditure for public work and relief. These items were not criticized but were thought managed in the best way under the circumstances.

The arrears of taxes came up for discussion including the reported school arrears and it was suggested that the Council get a definite ruling from the Department as to its liability in connection with the compulsory collection of such taxes.

The Calgary Power Company Franchise is due for renewal this year. This was much discussed and as the Council had had previous meetings with Acme and Triana on the matter it was thought that the Council was doing all that could be done.

Due to the insufficient water supply from the town well to take care of skating rink requirements, it was decided that something should be done in connection with the well. After much discussion it was thought that a new well would be a more satisfactory investment than trying to clean out the present well.

A Public Telephone pay station was much discussed. Andrew Schmidt, one of the Directors of the Mutual Telephone Board spoke at length on this subject and volunteered to bring to the Council further information in the near future.
