A special meeting of the Council of the Village of Beiseker was held in Mr Lount's office on May 17, 1938.

all councillors were present:-
F. A. Lount, Mayor
G. F. Weisagohet, Councillor
P. Schmaltz

The minutes of the previous meeting were read and adopted.

The date for the Court of Revision was set at 10 a.m. on May 23rd. The only appeal filed with the Secretary was that of the Royal Bank of Canada. Secretary to give appellants written notice of date.

The Mayor advised the Council that Peter Schneider had placed fire insurance on his property here and had made it payable to the Village of Beiseker, owing to the fact that he had moved his tools out of the shop and taken them to Calgary.

all persons owning cows had been asked to attend this meeting, but only the following attended:-

Much discussion took place as to cows running at large, contrary to By-law, also cows being pastured in the Village Park.

The parties present were asked to take their cows out of Park and to refrain from letting cows run at large and both parties agreed to do so.

The Village Constable also attended the meeting and agreed to advise other owners of cows as to the Council's decision.

Mr Lount advised the Council that he had been in Calgary re the Jennie Schmaltz hearing and that the date had been postponed to May 16th. He also advised that he had done considerable work in this connection in interviewing, Gertie Berrett, Arthur Berrett

George Schmaltz and the Child's Welfare Department, Calgary.
