By-law No. 45.

A. By-law of the Village of Beiseker relating to the mill rate for municipal purposes for 1939 and social services taxes for 1939.

The Council of the Village of Beiseker enacts as follows:-

That the mill rate for municipal purposes be eleven (11) mills and one (1) mill for social services taxes for 1939.

The above By-law received its first, second and third and was unanimously passed.
