


Sept. 26-1921

A Meeting of the Village Council was held in F. A. Joubert's office on the 26th day of Sept. 1921 all members present; the following business was transacted; -

Moved by C. F. Weingerber ^{seconded by F. A. Joubert} that the Secretary Treasurer be authorized to make an agreement with Paul Gelzler re dumping ground for the Village of Beiseker which is to be free gratis, and the restricted area for dumping is to be stacked out and all dray men notified as to such restrictions; -

Others who wish to do their draying shall be permitted to the use of this dumping ground by applying to the Secretary Treasurer for a permit, such permit shall be free, any person violating the rules and regulations of this dumping ground shall be fined \$10.00 and costs;

Moved by G. W. Buehring seconded by C. F. Weingerber that the Dog tax be one dollar for any dog for year 1922.
