The minutes of the previous meeting were read and adopted.

The financial statement for the month of May was submitted to the Council for discussion. The statement was found in order and signed by the Mayor.

During the sitting of this meeting the Council received word of the death of Andrew Schmaltz of near our Village.

owing to the fact that Mr Schmaltz had always taken a keen interest in sports and public life in our Village the Council declared a civic holiday for June 6th - the day of his funeral.

The following By-law was drawn
By-Law No. 47.

A By-Law of the Village of Beiseker proclaiming a Civic Holiday.

Under and by virtue of the Town & Village Act being Section 155, Chapter 49 of the Statutes of Alberta 1934, together with amendments thereto up to April 1938, the Council of the Village of Beiseker doth hereby decree that the sixth day of June A.D. 1940 shall be and is hereby declared a civic holiday within the Village of Beiseker.

The above By-law received three readings and was unanimously passed.

Done and passed in Council assembled this 4th day of June A.D. 1940.
