A special meeting of the Council and rate payers of the Village of Beiseker was held at Towns Office at 7.30 P.M. Minutes of previous meeting were read and adopted as read.

After a long discussion re buying land from Mrs. Seiler to enlarge town park, it was moved by E.M. Hagel 2nd by John Hirt that the Village Council be authorized to buy the parcel of land from Karl Seiler for the purpose of extending to straighten the Eastern boundary of the Beiseker play grounds. and it is also understood that the Council shall use their best judgement in regard of payments for above land.

Moved and second that J. Schmaltz is to look after the roads in the Village for this fall. Carried.

Moved and 2nd that J. Schmaltz be instructed to level a piece of ground in the public park about 40 x 100 for the purpose of a skating rink in the winter time same ground to be used for a tennis ground in the summer. Carried.

Moved and 2nd that the following bills are to be paid. H. D. Randle 6.50, C. Lambert 1.00, Rev. 1.20, J. Min 37.25, S. Datter 1.15, J. Schmitt 14.00, Royal Bank 1.00, Feyer 1.00, Jense 8.45. Carried
