A special meeting of the Council of the Village of Beiseker was held in Mr Laurent's office on above date.

The minutes of the previous meeting were read and adopted.

Mr Sam Kueger and Mr A. Reid, acting President and Secretary, respectively, of the Beiseker Curling Club attended the meeting to discuss and arrange settlement of the 1939-40 running expenses of the skating rink and the Beiseker Curling Rink.

The total expenditures were as follows:-

Caretaker	\$ 170.00
Coal	20.85
Lights	91.77.

A discussion took place as to what portion of the expenditures the Village should pay, and it was agreed by the Council and the officers of the Beiseker Curling Club that the Village pay on the following percentage basis,

50% of caretaking, being	\$ 60.00
40% of lights	36.71
33 1/3% of coal	6.85
making a total of	\$ 103.56.

The Village has, however, paid the lights in full for the season amounting to \$91.77 and a cheque for the difference of \$11.79 was authorized to be paid

to the Beiseker Curling Club.

On the suggestion of the Beiseker Curling Club it was moved by P. Schmaltz and seconded by E. F. Weisgerber that the Mayor of the Village of Beiseker be a member of the Beiseker Curling Club.

It was moved that the meeting adjourn.
