July 27, 1940

A special meeting of the Council of the Village of Beiseker was held in P.D. Laurent's office on July 27th

All Councilmen were present:-

The minutes of the previous meeting were read and adopted.

A number of the business men in the Village attended this meeting to discuss the graveling of 6th street and the continuation of same to connect with Highway No. 9.

After some discussion it was decided that the street in question be gravelled at once.

It was moved and seconded that Louis Schmaltz be the man for the job. carried.

It was moved and seconded that A. A. Wald make arrangements, for fine gravel, with P. Hallam at Irricana.

The Village agreed to pay for gravel hauled from pit, all gas and oil used in trucks for hauling gravel and pay men in pit for loading trucks.

All business men agreed to get trucks for hauling gravel free of charge to the Village.
