


Done and passed in Council assembled this 31st day of December 1940.




Several letters were read from W. H. Patterson, solicitor Calgary, making application for exemption of taxes on behalf of Red A. Galtz who is serving in the Canadian Active Service Force.

The Council after some discussion moved that his property, being Lots 14, 15 & 16, Block 1, Plan 4011X Beiseker, be exempt from assessment and taxation until he ceased to be a soldier, and also that the taxes for the year 1940 be cancelled as the levy was made after he enlisted.
