A special meeting of the Village Council of Beaver was held in F. J. Courts office Nov 5 - at 7:30 P.M.

Minutes of previous were read and adopted or read, Carried -

After long discussion regarding ice matters in rink it was moved & 2nd that J. Schmalz be engaged to put in foundation for ice and to make a sheet of ice ready for skating, also to erect post for light will as directed by Mr. Jersa. - Carried.

Moved and 2nd that J. Schmalz be authorized to procure a suitable building and store for waiting room. - Carried

Moved and 2nd that the proprietors of Mr. Jersa to manage the rink from the time the ice is laid through the skating season on the following terms, be accepted.

Skating every ~~afternoon from 2 to 5~~ Tuesday Thursday and Saturday from 2 to 5 in the afternoon and from 7 to 10 in evening, and also the school children at a season ticket for 50¢ each and adults \$2.00 each for season ticket and the other 3 days and nights of the week is for the benefit of Mr. Jersa as he may see fit.

An extra charge to all season tickets in event the management should furnish music.

Weather governs all conditions.
