The minutes of the last meeting were read and adopted.

- .. 60 Royal Bank of Canada, Street lights, 30.00

Financial Statement for the month ending June 30th was submitted to Council and approved and filed herewith.

The Council advised the parties, who had bought lots at Tax Sale, that as soon as Tax Notifications, filed at the Land Titles office, were released and proper form of transfers obtained transfers would be drawn and delivered to them.

Mr. Reid, Secretary of the Curling Club attended the meeting and submitted a statement of expenses paid by the Curling Club for the 1940-41 curling season as follows:-

Caretaking	\$150.00
Coal	\$22.65

In accordance with arrangements made with the curling club in previous seasons the Village agreed to pay expenses on percentage basis:-

- 50% of caretaking
- 33 1/3% of coal
- 40% of lights

The lights for the season amounted to \$108.20 which was paid in full by the village.
