The Mayor brought to the attention of the Council the Municipal Inspector's Report. The report was read, discussed and ordered to be filed.

Mr. A. P. Smith of the Calgary Power Company interviewed the Council in connection with a new agreement changing the electric light rate. Mr. Smith presented a statement showing that the new rate would benefit 75% of the consumers in our Village. By-law No. 49 (as incorporated in our By-Law Book) received its first reading. Three copies of By-law were signed by the Mayor & Secretary and returned to the Calgary Power Co. to be approved by the Board of Public Utilities.
