November 1st. 1941

A meeting of the Council of the Village of Beiseker was held in F.A. Laurent's office on the above date with the following present, F.A. Laurent, Mayor, S.F. Messenger, Parish Clerk, and Louis K. Schmaltz.

The Secretary advised that only one nomination for councillor had been received on October 24<sup>th</sup>, that of, Louis K. Schmaltz and that he had been elected by acclamation for the term ending February 1942.

Louis K. Schmaltz at took the oath of office, copy of which is filed herewith.

The minutes of the previous meeting were read and adopted.

The payment of the following cheques authorized:-

The matter of culverts for newly graded streets came up for discussion. It was moved that 50' of 18" ~~of~~ concrete pipe be purchased from Concrete Products and Supplies, Calgary, carried.

L. K. Schmaltz was asked to get in touch with Frank Schmaltz and have same brought out by truck at once.

The matter of repairing sidewalk from the corner of 6<sup>th</sup> St. to school was discussed as well as other sidewalks that might require some work. so Louis K. Schmaltz volunteered to act a price on such repair work in wood and cement.

The Financial Statement for the month ending October 31<sup>st</sup> was submitted to the Council and signed by the Mayor.
