A meeting of the Council of the Village of Beiseker was held Aug. 3, 1947 in F.A. Launt's office with all councillors present, namely:-

The minutes of the last meeting were read and adopted.

The financial statements for the month of June and July were submitted. The statements were perused and signed by the Mayor.

The estimate for 1947, was presented to the Council. All items were checked, discussed and adopted. The sheet was placed on a special file.

By-Law No. 53 authorizing current Municipal Tax Levy was drawn up as follows:-

a By-Law of the Village of Beiseker authorizing the current Municipal Tax Levy.

Whereas, the estimated expenditure for the Village of Beiseker for the year 1947 is \$1573.25 as per estimate in detail duly recorded; and

The mill rate for partial services tax was set at 11/20 of a mill on land & improvements being 7128.075

Whereas, the total assessed valuation of taxable property within the said Village, as shown by the assessment roll, is as follows:-

Land	\$ 16,700.00
Buildings and Improvements	111,375.00
Special (Calgary Power Co. 'Works')	6200.00
Total assessment	\$ 134,275.00

And, whereas it is estimated that the sum of \$160.00 will be collected from sources other than current levy, thus leaving the amount to be collected from current taxes \$ 1,413.85

So which is to be added for non-collection 57.57

Making the total current taxes to be levied 1470.82

Therefore, the Secretary-Treasurer of the said Village is hereby authorized to raise the said amount, namely: \$ 1470.82, by a levy upon all Land, Buildings and Improvements assessed therein, at a rate of eleven (11) mills on the dollar of assessed value, for Municipal purposes.

And in addition thereto a levy of ten (10) mills upon special assessed property therein, as set by the Department of Municipal Affairs, to raise the amount of \$62.00 for Municipal purposes as well.

The above By-Law received its first, second and third reading and was finally unanimously passed.

It was moved that a discount of 5% be given on taxes paid on or before October 1st, 1947. ~~It was moved that the meeting adjourn~~
