A meeting of the Council of the Village of Beiseker was held in F.A. Laurent's office on July 3, 1943.

All councillors attended the meeting, namely,

F.A. Laurent Mayor  
C.F. Weisgerber, Councillor  
L.B. Schmaltz

The minutes of the last meeting were read and adopted.

The financial statement for the month ending June 30<sup>th</sup> was presented to the Council for consideration. The statement was signed by the Mayor and is filed herewith.

The payment of the following cheques was confirmed:-

No. 39	Geo Weisgerber, assessor	50.00
- 40	Royal Bank of Canada, street lights	30.00
- 41	Nick Schmaltz, work on streets	37.80
- 42	Geo J. Selzer, sanitation	6.00

The sidewalk on the south side of 6<sup>th</sup> Street between the alley and the property known as the City Land came up for discussion as the old walk is beyond repair the Council resolved to put in a new 4 ft. cement walk. The Council then appointed as a committee councillors Schmaltz & Weisgerber to oversee the construction of such walk and were authorized to pay \$1.25 per cubic yard for gravel and rock required.

It was brought to the attention of councillor Schmaltz that the fence enclosing the skating rink be repaired and that the waiting room should be locked and the gate securely fastened.

Moved that the meeting adjourn.
