The petition was discussed at length and it was decided that the following By-laws be drawn up:-
By-law No. 29 A

A By-law to repeal By-laws No 24, 24(a) and 29.

The Council of the Village of Buisick enacts as follows:-

That By-laws number 24, 24(a) and 29 be and are hereby repealed.

By-law No. 57

A By-law of the Village of Buisick to regulate the closing of places of business.

The Council of the Village of Buisick enacts as follows:-

That all places of business, except garages, service stations, post rooms, restaurants, hotels, grain elevators and places of business under Government control, shall open at 8 o'clock a. m. and close at 6 o'clock p. m., daily except Saturday when the closing hour shall be 11 o'clock p. m. and Wednesday when the closing hour shall be 1 o'clock p. m. except for the period from August 15th to October 15th in each year when the closing hour for Wednesday shall be 6 o'clock p. m.

The above By-laws received first and second reading.

It was moved that the meeting adjourn.
