The Secretary was instructed to post the required notices in connection with the Annual meeting, nomination & the financial statement for the year ending Dec. 31/43.

The matter of a Village police came up for discussion and owing to the fact that a local man proved very inefficient in the enforcement of Village by laws, it was moved by L. B. Schmeltz that a letter be written to the Commissioner, R. C. M. P. at Ottawa, for information regarding the policing of the Village by their R. C. M. P. stationed at Erieville. Carried.

Moved by L. B. Schmeltz that the meeting adjourn.
