

Beiseker, Ala.

A meeting of the Council of the Village of Beiseker was held in F. A. Raunt's office on May 29, 1944. All councillors were present, namely, F. A. Raunt, C. F. Weisgerber & R. L. Schmaltz. Minutes of the last meeting were read and adopted.

Payment of the following cheques was confirmed:-

Financial statement for the month of May was submitted, discussed and signed by the Mayor.

Moved by C. F. Weisgerber that we purchase a street grader from Louis Schmaltz for a sum of \$160.00 and that the machine be stored on his premises and be kept under his supervision. carried.

Building and maintenance of sidewalks was discussed and it was moved by C. F. Weisgerber that Louis Schmaltz be authorized to repair old sidewalks where necessary and to build a new cement walk 8 feet wide from the West corner of Gutman's store through to the East corner of Block 1 and a 4 foot cement walk on the West side of 2nd Avenue from the D. R. corner of Block 1 to the school gate at an estimated cost of \$600.00 for the complete construction of the new walk. carried.

The Secretary was asked to prepare estimate for the year 1944 for approval of the Council.

The assessment of Village property for school purposes came up for discussion and it was moved by Louis Schmaltz that we use our basis of assessment for the year 1944 and that for the year 1945 we engage an expert assessor to revise our complete assessment. carried.

Moved by Louis Schmaltz that the meeting adjourn.
