2d meeting of the Council of the Village of Beiseker was held in F. A. Kountz's office on June 3rd 1944.

Minutes of the last meeting were read and adopted.

The estimate for the year 1944 was submitted to the Council for consideration. all items were checked, discussed and adopted and the following By-law was drawn up.

By-law No. 61 authorizing current Municipal Tax Levy.

Whereas, the estimated expenditure for the Village of Beiseker for the year 1944 is \$2547.82 as per estimate in detail duly recorded; and

Whereas, the total assessed valuation of taxable property within the said Village, as shown by the assessment roll, is as follows:

Land	\$16,975.00
Buildings and Improvements	115,662.00
Special (Calgary River Co. "Wakas")	<u>6,300.00</u>
Total assessment	\$138,937.00

And, whereas, it is estimated that the sum of \$230.00 will be collected from sources other than current Levy, thus leaving the amount to be collected from current taxes \$2317.82.

Therefore, the Secretary Treasurer of the said Village is hereby authorized to raise the said amount, namely \$2317.82, by a levy upon all land, buildings and improvements assessed therein at a rate of 17 mills on the dollar of assessed value, for municipal purposes and a levy of 10 mills on special assessed property.

It was moved by C. F. Weisgerber that a discount of 5% be allowed on current taxes if paid on or before August 31st 1944.

The Secretary was asked to prepare the Tax Roll and to send out Tax Notices not later than August 1st 1944.
