A meeting of the Council of the Village of Beiseker was held in F. A. Laurent's office on June 19, 1945.

All councillors were present, namely,

C. F. Weisgerber
L. L. Schmaltz.

Minutes of the last meeting were read and adopted.

Financial statements for the months of March, April and May were submitted, signed by the Mayor and filed herewith.

The estimate for the year 1945 was submitted to the Council for consideration. All items were discussed and adopted and the following By-law drawn up:-

By-law No. 68^{915.} authorizing current tax levy.

Whereas, the estimated expenditure for the Village of Beiseker for the year 1945 is \$6792.26 as per estimate in detail duly recorded; and

Whereas, the total assessed Valuation of Taxable Property within the said Village, as shown by the assessment roll, is as follows:-

And, whereas, it is estimated that the sum of 268.91 will be collected from sources other than current levy, thus leaving the amount to be collected from current taxes = \$6523.35

Therefore, the Secretary-Treasurer of the said Village is hereby authorized to raise the said amount, namely: \$6523.35, by a levy upon all rateable property therein, at a rate of 17 mills on the dollar of assessed value, for municipal purposes.

And in addition thereto, a levy of 20 mills for school purposes upon all rateable property inside the Village limits. As also a levy of 10 mills upon special assessed property for municipal purposes.

The above By-Law was given three readings and unanimously passed.

Mr Steve Bilbernaegel attended the meeting in connection with his account for removal of garbage and ashes. The Council was of the opinion that the cost of \$2.00 per load for hauling ashes was excessive. The matter was discussed with Mr. Bilbernaegel and it was agreed that \$1.75 per load be paid for garbage and the same amount for ashes.

Mr. Bilbernaegel was also reminded that the garbage must be hauled to the nuisance ground on Saturday of each week.

A building permit to erect a brick and tile building 50x60x14 on the south side of 6th street on Block 9, Plan 5948 A.W. to be used as a machine shop, was issued to Adam Velker.
