Nov. 22nd 1946.

A meeting of the Council of the Village of Beiseker was held in Mr Laurent's office on Friday, November 22, 1946, with all members of the Council present, namely, F. A. Laurent, L. L. Schmaltz and C. F. Weisgerber.

Minutes of the last meeting were read and adopted.

L. L. Schmaltz, President of the Curling Club presented a statement showing the amounts paid during the 1945-46 curling and skating season,

Total expenses

After much discussion it was decided that the Village of Beiseker pay 65% of total expenses, and that the percentage as paid in former years, which amounts to \$569.60 but the amount already paid by the Village is \$597.82 therefore the Curling Club shall pay to the Village the sum of 28.22, being the difference between 597.82 and 569.60.

The fee for ^{skating} 1946-47 was discussed and it was decided the tickets be \$1.00 for each for any boy or girl attending public or high school.
\$2.00 for any adult.
and no family tickets to be sold this year.

L. L. Schmaltz was asked to interview Frank J. Schmaltz as to caretaking of rinks for 1946-47 season and to engage him as such if at all possible.

The Inspector's Report, D.M.A. was read and the suggestions contained therein noted and discussed and the Secretary was authorized to advise the Department accordingly and place report on file.



Mayor, F.A. Laurent was authorized to complete the proposal of the C.N.R. as to the exchange of certain lands in connection with the extension of 6th Street and Crescent Drive and the closing of 9th Street crossing etc all of which is particularly described on blue print.

The Mayor was further instructed ^{to work} with Mr. McKittrick, A.L.S. and arrange to meet him in Calgary to complete the registration of our survey.
