The Municipal Inspector's Report was read and comments and recommendations noted by the Council. The Mayor asked that the report be placed on file and advised that acknowledgment of same would be forwarded to the Department of Municipal Affairs.

The Secretary advised that Duplicate Certificate of Title No. 22-F-63 covering Block "R" Plan 8292 C.H. in the name of the Village of Beiseker has been received from the Department of Public Works, Edmonton.

Repairs to the skating rink came up for discussion and the Council viewed the rink for the purpose of determining whether or not it would be advisable to spend money to repair the rink. It was found that the lumber had decayed beyond repair and it was decided that a new rink and waiting room be built. On looking up our records it was found that the rink had served the Village for almost 20 years without much repair.

Frank Schmaltz was asked to give us a price on construction of new rink. He was not prepared to quote a price but was willing to cooperate with us and agreed to tear down the old building and fence and salvage as much lumber as possible. Frank Schmaltz advised that a number of boys had offered their services, free of charge, to take down the old building and fence.
