

February 16, 1926

- (1) A special meeting of the Village Council was held in J. A. Lount's office on above date. All members of the board present.
- (2) The minutes of the previous meeting were read and adopted. Carried.
- (3) The application of Fred Kloepfer for the construction of a building to be used as a butcher shop was thoroughly discussed, but he later decided to rent a building so the discussion closed. Carried.
- (4) By-Law no. 22, Regulating the Storage and Handling of Inflammable Liquid, received its first, second and third reading and was finally unanimously passed. Carried.
- (5) By-Law no. 23, Regulating the Construction and Remodelling of Buildings, received its first, second and third reading and finally unanimously passed. Carried.
- (6) It was moved and seconded that the Rec. and Sec. Treas. be authorized to borrow from the Board of the Buisick Consolidated S. D. No. 55, the sum of Five Hundred dollars (\$500.00) for a term of eighteen months at 6% per annum interest to cover the purchase of five acres of land as additional playground or park. Carried.
