Results of Council Election

I attended at the Columbus Club Hall, at Beiseles, Alberta for the purpose of presiding over the election of councilors for the Village of Beiseles on Monday 23rd, 1948

At 10 o'clock in the forenoon I declared the poll open, unlocked, examined, and locked the ballot box, appointed W. J. Lavoie as poll clerk, and proceeded with the election.

At 7 o'clock in the afternoon I declared the poll as closed, unlocked the ballot box in the presence of the authorized agents, poll clerk, and candidate Leo J. Schmalz, and proceeded with the counting of the ballots. The results were as follows:

Leo J. Schmalz - Eighty-five votes
Adam Velin - Forty-one vote
Two spoiled ballots

I declared Leo J. Schmalz as the newly elected councilor, and I declared the results publicly on Tuesday the 24th day of February, 1948 at ten o'clock in the forenoon.
