A meeting of the Council of the Village of Beiseker was held in F. A. Hunt's office on March 1, 1948 with all councillors present F. A. Hunt, H. H. Schmalz, and Leo J. Schmalz.

The meeting was called to order, and the result of the election, as given by the Returning Officer declared:

That Leo J. Schmalz was elected councillor over Adam Velber by a vote of eighty-five votes to forty-one with two ballots spoiled. Leo J. Schmalz's term of office to run for three years ending February 1951.

Leo J. Schmalz signed the declaration of office for councillor.

Moved by Leo J. Schmalz that F. A. Hunt be mayor for the year 1948. Carried
