A special meeting of the Council of the Village of Buisseret was held in S. A. Lount's Office on March 27th 1926.

The following business was transacted:

Andrew Schmaltz was paid the sum of Four Hundred and Ninety-seven dollars (\$497.00) for additional park grounds, said money being borrowed from Buisseret Consolidated S. D. No. 55. as authorized in minutes of meeting Feb. 16, 1926.

The Court of Revision was then opened at 10 o'clock and the following changes made and approved by said Court:-
