A special meeting of the Council of the Village of Bismarck was held in H. A. Jounts' office on March 30th.

The Recr and Secretary-Treasurer to borrow \$497.00 on a promissory note from the Bismarck Consolidated S. D. \$5. Said note to bear interest at the rate of six per cent per annum and payable Dec. 18, 1926. Carried

After a long discussion re the building of side-walks and owing to the fact that the expense of same was greater than could be taken care of with the current taxes, it was therefore decided to table this question until next year. Map of proposed sidewalks and estimates will be found on file.

It was moved and seconded that Joseph Schmatz was to arrange for permanent use of nuisance ground and if possible to arrange agreement of sale with the present owner under the same terms as his contract calls for and to notify Council if any such arrangements are possible at once so that the Village may have the privilege of the use of this ground without any delay. Carried.

The Tax Roll was approved and signed by the Council and a levy of 10 mills was set and 2 mills supplementary rate was authorized.


A discount of ten per cent was allowed on all taxes paid on or before the 30th day of April, 1926.


Gasoline situation was again thoroughly discussed and Mr. Fox was authorized to have same removed in twenty-four hours or take action to have same removed.
