

April 13/26

A special meeting of the Council of the Village of Biscuff was held in H. A. Lount's office on April 13th.

The meeting was called to order at 8:30 p.m. and the following business transacted.

- (1) The minutes of the previous meeting were read and adopted. carried
- (2) The Secretary was authorized to write the different Elevators and Oil Companies regarding whether the land occupied by them respectively were assessable or not, and to write the R.P.R. regarding information for same.
- (3) The Secretary was authorized to issue a cheque for \$2.00 in payment of stamps and also to pay note at Royal Bank.
- (4) The taxation of separators on the rear of Aisenstat's lots was discussed on the complaint of E. N. Hagel and it was decided that no change be made.
- (5) The matter of Geo. Batch blockading street and side-walk in front of his place was discussed and police is to have same removed at once.
- (6) Andrew Schmalz's verbal ~~at~~ statement, requesting damages for pasture destroyed by fire of unknown origin, was thoroughly discussed and it was moved and seconded that such request could not be granted without positive proof that it was through the negligence of the Village that such fire was originated and that such proof should be accompanied by a written statement of such damages and also proof that such damages are correct.
- (7) The Herd By-Law was amended to read April 1st instead of May 15th. Such amendment receiving its first, second and

third reading and finally unanimously passed.

The offer of W.S. Schulz to sell to the Village of Busker a piece of land to be used as a nuisance ground was thoroughly discussed and it was moved and seconded that this offer be accepted and a contract for such land made with W.S. Schulz.
